**SERVICE OPTIC** – “Any rifle with optic sights with no restriction on slings. Rests may not be used. The rifle magazine may touch or rest on the forearm or on the ground. (Any forward vertical grip, if fitted, may **not** be used).”

**PRACTICAL OPTIC** - "Any rifle with optic sights, with no restriction on slings or rests. If any rest is utilised it must remain fitted to the rifle at all times during the match".

**SUNDAY MORNING 14<sup>th</sup> February 2010**

**NRA SERVICE RIFLE 'INTERNATIONAL SR' COMPETITIONS**  
**(AMENDED FOR BOLT ACTION RIFLES)**

**Stage 1 - The 100x Standing**

- Type of practice - Snap
- Distance – 100 yards
- Position - Standing followed by kneeling or squatting
- Rounds – 2 Sighting shots, 10 to count
- Targets – One DP14 window target
- Procedure
  1. Competitors are to be in the standing ready alert position with rifles loaded
  2. The target will make five double exposures of '3 seconds up, 2 seconds down, 3 seconds up' at irregular intervals over a period of 2 minutes

The first shot at each double exposure is to be fired from the standing position and the second shot from either the sitting or squatting positions. Firers must return to the ready alert position after each double exposure

**Stage 2 - The 200x Bisley Bullet**

- Type of practice - Snap
- Distance – 200 yards
- Position - Prone
- Rounds - 2 sighting shots, 10 to count
- Targets - One DP14 window target
- Procedure
  1. On completion of the sighting shots, rifles will be made ready with ten rounds
  2. Targets will make ten appearances of three seconds at various places over a 6ft frontage at irregular intervals of between 5 and 20 seconds

One shot only to be fired at each exposure.

**Stage 3 - The 300x Kinnaird**

- Type of practice - Timed
- Distance – 300 yards
- Position - Prone
- Rounds - 2 sighting shots, 10 to count
- Targets – DP2
- Procedure

1. After the two sighting shots have been fired and signalled back, firers will be ordered to apply safety catches and adopt the standing ready alert position
2. On the appearance of the targets for 60 seconds, they will adopt the prone position and fire ten rounds
3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 25 seconds

#### **Stage 4 - The 400 yard Sitting**

- Type of practice - Rapid
- Distance – 400 yards
- Position - Sitting
- Rounds – 2 Sighting shots, 10 to count
- Targets – Triple DP 1
- Scoring – 5 on the central target for a hit inside the 300mm circle, 4 for a hit elsewhere on the central target and 2 for a hit anywhere on the other two targets.
- Procedure
  1. Competitors are to be in the ready alert position with rifles loaded
  2. On appearance of the targets for 60 seconds competitors are to adopt the sitting position and engage targets.
  3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 25 seconds.

#### **Stage 5 - The 500x Harassing Fire**

- Type of practice - Rapid
- Distance – 500 yards
- Position – Prone Unsupported
- Rounds – 2 Sighting shots, 10 to count
- Targets – Triple DP 1
- Scoring – 5 on the central target for a hit inside the 300mm circle, 4 for a hit elsewhere on the central target and 2 for a hit anywhere on the other two targets.
- Procedure
  1. Competitors are to be in the ready alert position with rifles loaded
  2. On appearance of the targets for 60 seconds competitors are to adopt the prone position and engage targets.
  3. Scores will be communicated to the firing point and spotting discs shown for 25 seconds.

### **SUNDAY 14<sup>th</sup> PM – MIX AND MATCH    Century Range**

#### **Stage 1 - 300 Yard Assault**

Distance: 300 yards.

Position: Standing Alert to Prone Unsupported.

Shots: 10 to count.

Target: One DP2 scoring 5 and 4.

Timing: 90 seconds.

Procedure: Start in the loaded Standing Alert position on the 400 yard firing point. When the targets are exposed advance to the 300 yards adopt the Prone position, make ready and engage the target with 10 rounds.

### **Stage 2 - 300 Yard Rapid Fire Prone**

Distance: 300 yards.

Position: Standing Alert to Prone Unsupported.

Shots: 2 sighters and 10 to count (**Requires a mag change, 1 mag of 2, 1 mag of 8**).

Target: One DP2 scoring 5s and 4s.

Timing: 60 Seconds.

Procedure: Start in the Standing Alert position on the 300 yard firing point. When the targets are exposed, adopt the prone position, make ready and engage target with 10 rounds (note mag change)

### **Stage 3 - 200 Yard Assault**

Distance: 200 yards.

Position: Standing Alert to Kneeling or Squatting.

Shots: 10 to count.

Target: One DP2 scoring 5 and 4.

Timing: 90 seconds.

Procedure: Start in the loaded Standing Alert position on the 300 yard firing point. When the targets are exposed advance to 200 yards assume the Kneeling or Squatting position, make ready and engage the target with 10 rounds.

### **Stage 4 - 200 Yard Rapid Fire Sitting**

Distance: 200 yards.

Position: Standing Alert to Sitting.

Shots: 2 sighters and 10 to count (**Requires a mag change, 1 mag of 2, 1 mag of 8**).

Target: One DP2 12 scoring 5s and 4s.

Timing: 50 seconds.

Procedure: Start in the loaded Standing Alert position on the 200 yard firing point. When the targets are exposed adopt the sitting position, make ready and engage the target with 10 rounds. (note mag change)

### **Stage 5 - 100 Yard Assault**

Distance: 100 yards.

Position: Standing Alert to Standing.

Shots: 10 to count.

Target: DP2 window target, scoring 5 and 4.

Timing: 90 seconds.

Procedure: Start in the loaded Standing Alert position on the 200 yard firing point. When the targets are exposed advance to 100 yards, adopt the Standing position, make ready and engage the target with 10 rounds.
