Membership runs from 1st January to 31st December. Annual Subscriptions are due on 1st January each year.

**1st year membership is set at a special introductory rate of £40.** Please note that this introductory rate can be paid by Direct Debit. The NRA encourages renewal by Direct Debit which makes for ease of payment for members for which there is a £2.50 discount on all categories.

Life Membership subscriptions may be paid in a lump sum or by Banker's Standing Order over a seven year period. Junior Life Membership is available from age 14 to 25 at just £200. For further details please contact the Membership Department.

If you pay UK income tax (including tax paid on state or personal pensions) and would like to increase the value of your subscription (both Life and Annual) by 20% to the NRA you can sign a Gift Aid Declaration. There is no extra cost to yourself but if you are a higher rate tax payer the actual cost to you of your subscription is reduced by 20%.

## Benefits of FULL NRA Membership

1. The support of the NRA in all matters connected with target shooting.
2. To stand for General Council and to vote at General Meetings and Elections.
3. To receive a copy of the Annual Report, always included in the Summer Journal.
4. To receive the NRA Journal.
5. To hire firearms by the day, within the provisions of the Firearms Acts.
6. To purchase ammunition from the NRA, within the provisions of the Firearms Acts.
7. To hire targets on Bisley Ranges.
8. To wear the NRA colours.
9. To shoot in the Imperial Meeting.
10. Admission to the Members' enclosures on the Ranges and at the Presentation of Prizes (on production of badge or card).
11. To be covered under the Members' Insurance Policy.
12. To be eligible for selection for GB and NRA representative teams.
