Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q: How much are the cost of the sessions
A: £15 for half day (am/pm)
£30 for full day

2. Q: What Ammunition is provided and at what cost
A: Ammunition is provided. 7.62 ammunition Cost is £11 per 20 rounds. We also provide 303, 223, 357, .22 at price. Any other ammunition needs to be purchase at the Range office

3. Q: What time do the sessions start and where do I sign in
A: 8.30 am and 1.30pm
On Century in the Morning and Stickledown in the afternoon
An email is sent out the day before detailing the targets that are being used. Please sign in the log book under your surname and also sign in at the Range Office as this will help with a new or renewal of your Firearms certificate.

- 4 Q: Are Rifles and other kit provided
A: Yes. If you need to borrow anything (rifles, mat, scope etc), please specify your requirements when either ringing or emailing to book

- 5 Q: Do I need to ring or email to book a place
A: Yes. We need to know in advance so we can determine how many targets we need to book. Please also specify which distances you Would like to shoot at.

6. Q: I don't have a certification card, can I shoot
A: No. Unless you are a probationary member you will not be able to shoot. If you do not have one we can either do an assessment for you at a later date or if you belong to an affiliated club you should be able to get a card from them.

7. Q: I have just finished my probationary course, what do I need to do.
A: You need to book 3 separate sessions and sign in on the day. The coach will then take you to the appropriate range where you will be supervised on a one to one basis. Once the 3 sessions have taken place, you will then be considered to be upgraded to a full member
