ACCOMPANYING NOTES

Further required information

Note 1: All clubs are legally obliged to inform the Police if a member, who holds a Firearms Certificate, has not shot at the Club for a period of 12 months. The Attendance Records for NRA members are kept in the NRA Range Office.

Note 2: The Applicant must hold a current Firearms Certificate showing authority to shoot on approved ranges as a HOA club member (valid for at least three months from the date of application). The original certificate should be supplied (though 2 photocopies will be acceptable - all 4 pages please), it will be returned to the holder by recorded delivery by return or as soon as possible. Your HOA club must appear on your FAC. If your FAC is only for Vermin Control you may have to attend an assessment

Note 3: The enclosed form must be completed by your HOA club secretary confirming full membership of that club, that the member is of good standing within the club and detailing any shooting related incidents that could give cause for concern. The applicant may not be related to the club secretary. If they are then another club officer may complete the form.

or

Note 4: A letter must be provided from an existing or former Commanding Officer / Chief Constable confirming that you have been trained in the use of firearms in accordance with your application plus the 2 completed referee forms, the applicant must not be related to either of the referees.

Note 5: If the first three requirements are not met satisfactorily, completion of Probationary Membership is necessary to subsequently qualify for full membership. This will involve attending a regular course of instruction over a period of at least 3 months. Please contact the Membership Secretary for probationary information and an application form.

Gift Aid declaration

Note 6: There's a quick and simple way in which you can make your membership subscription and donations worth 20% more to the NRA, at no extra cost to you.
